

General information

- Submitted short paper (8-10 pages of A-4 format) for Applied Geophysics 2018 only consider work that has not been published and is not being considered for publication elsewhere.
- Short papers will be published in formula open access in accordance with the Policy on Publishing Integrity of E3S Web of Conferences. You can find the last Applied Geophysics 2017 Proceedings at address:

- Every paper will be identified, like any journal article, for indexing and abstracting e.g. like a DOI enabling the cross-referencing. All texts will be free to read and download.
- Texts will be indexed in **Web of Sciences, Google Scholar, Scopus, and others.**
- The attendance in Applied Geophysics 2018 conference at least one author of proceeding paper is required.
- A maximum of two short papers per author is accepted. At least one author of each text should attend to the conference.

Hints for article preparation (research type)

- **Introduction**
State the objectives of the work and provide an adequate background. Methods that are already published should be summarized, and indicated by a reference. If quoting directly from a previously published method, use quotation marks and also cite the source. Any modifications to existing methods should also be described.
- **Theory/ Methodology**
A theory/ methodology section should extend, not repeat, the background to the article already mentioned with in the Introduction and lay the foundation for presented work. Section represents a practical development from a theoretical basis.
- **Results and discussion**
Results should be clear and concise. Discussion should explore the significance of the results of the work, not repeat them.
- **Conclusions**
The main conclusions of the study may be presented in a short section, which may stand alone.

Process of publication

- The paper should be written as a MS WORD document according to the enclosed template with editorial guidelines.
- The paper can not be longer than 8 - 10 pages of A-4 format including abstract, figures, tables and references. We suggest the need of text editing by native speaker.

- The paper should be submitted to the editor-in-chief: **pilecki@meeri.pl up to August 30, 2018** together with copyright agreement signed by Authors.
- Papers will be reviewed with double-blind standards.
- Payment for paper publication should be made after receiving the positive decision from editor within 10 days.
- No possibility to make changes in published text.

Ethical Publication Practices

Web of Conferences proceedings are committed to the standards of publishing integrity and academic honesty. Editors, reviewers and authors are encouraged to refer to **The Committee on Publishing Ethics (COPE)** and to follow its **Code of conduct** and **guidelines**.

Serious misconduct (for example, data fabrication, falsification or plagiarism) is taken seriously into consideration and is further investigated. When a suspicion of misconduct turns out to be confirmed, the available sanction is applied.

Proceedings' Requirements

The proceedings make clear their *aims and scope, editorial policy and manuscript requirements* in terms of presentation and submissions.

- Authors are expected to pursue objectiveness and rigour in all aspects of their work. Authors are obligated to provide retractions or corrections of mistakes.
- The list of authors should accurately reflect who did the work.
- Editors, authors and peer reviewers are encouraged to disclose interests that might appear to affect their ability to present or review data objectively.

Peer Review

All published articles are peer reviewed. Reviews will be conducted by expert referees, who have been requested to provide unbiased and constructive comments aimed, whenever possible, at improving the work.
